- Minimum Wage Results After a five hour hearing at the city council meeting last week, the council passed the following by a 6-2 vote:
 - \$13 by 2019 with a path to \$15 in 2021. Starting January 1, 2017 at \$10.50 In addition there is a one year delay for small businesses with less than 25 employees and nonprofits. So, they would start in Jan, 1, 2018
 - Youth Training Wage of 85% of the local minimum wage for six months or 480 hours
 - There was an incentive added for the expansion of local providers not sure what that entails.
 - Strong enforcement of the new wage law by the City of LB with the possibility of fines for employers who don't follow the rules
 - From 2023 on, the minimum wage increases would be indexed to inflation within the Greater Los Angeles area,
 - Future study in 2019 if the study determined that were no negative impacts then the wage would rise to \$14 in 2020 and to \$15 in 2021.
- **Bike Courier Delivery Service** We have been approached by Nashional Courier Service to offer delivery services for our restaurants or any business wanting such services. The business currently operates out of Lola's on 4th Street and want to make a second home at the Lola's Bixby Knolls location. How it works: Someone can order food from the participating business through food apps like Grub Hub or Eat 24 (but they can go direct to the business), the couriers get notified immediately and go pick up the order from the restaurant and deliver it by bike. In three months, the service made 2000 deliveries from the 4th Street location from as far to Catalina Express and 2nd & PCH. The service would be offered from Del Amo to Willow, river to Cherry. The couriers can usually deliver within 7 minutes. This is a great service to get the businesses on board with to expand their customer base and reach. We will help spread the word to the businesses and Nashional will work out the individual agreements.
