### Bixby Knolls Business Improvement Association Executive Director Report: March 2018

General updates from around the district:

- **RDA Funding:** I will be drafting a letter to the city on behalf of the BKBIA discussing the impending sunset of our RDA contract funds. The letter will be submitted to the mayor, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> district council office, city manager, and director of economic development. The intent is to get on the record the work accomplished by the BKBIA with its use of the RDA funds for nearly 10 years. This of course includes the addition of staff, the growth of First Fridays, and all of the façade improvements and streetscape work to improve the district.
- Neighborhood Survey: We have recently posted on Facebook and sent an email to our entire lists requesting comments from residents as to what businesses they would like to see in Bixby Knolls. It was time to do this again but the real catalyst was the discussion in the Bixby Knolls Task Group. We can share the results of the survey with the brokers and property owners we are more engaged with (and to reach out to others). This is data "from the horse's mouth" to help steer the conversations about what the neighborhood would be want and support. We can make the best recommendations to property owners when we know what the residents are saying.
- Business Directory with the Signal Tribune: While preparing the presentation for the Annual Meeting I took a look at the hard copy of the BKBIA Business Directory from 2013. I thought that it may be time to revisit doing this again since we have had new businesses come to the district and plenty of new residents who have moved here. I met with Neena of the Signal Tribune to talk about the possibility of doing this again. After the last time we all swore we wouldn't do it again. I do believe it is worth pursuing and the Signal will be doing most of the work. We will continue to make sure our spreadsheet of current members is accurate before submitting it to the paper for formatting into the book. Neena will come to our next business breakfast to talk to the members about the advertising opportunities. We will also share this information via direct mail, email, and posting to our members-only Facebook page. The book will go to all businesses and to at least 12,000 homes in the area. We will design the cover, add all the information about the BKBIA, and proof the book when ready. I will provide updates on this as we move along. Start date for ad sales and reservations: May 1
- **4262 Atlantic Avenue** George Mitri of Baba Ghanouj is working on the build out and renovations for this space. He looks to open in another month and a half. I'll stay in touch to get the restaurant's name, menu, and full concept.
- **3440 Atlantic** The doctor who owns the property is now complete with his total makeover of the property. The interior has been transformed into a modern medical facility for plastic surgery and small procedures. The exterior landscaping is being worked on now by our landscaper and this is one of our RDA projects.
- West Bistro: Work is continuing steadily. Parking lot was redone, open rooftop was cleaned up, paper is down from windows and crews seem to be there during the week. Still trying to get a name, opening date, and actual list of food options/vendors.

Katie Phillips introduced herself as the new BKBIA Admin/Project Manager.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

• Approval of Minutes from January 25, 2018. Katherine made a motion to approve the minutes. Debbie seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.

• Berenice talked about the recent vandalism to her store. A window had been shot out. There have been a number of businesses in Bixby Knolls and North Long Beach that have windows shot out by pellet gun.

#### **7th District Council Office Report**

No report given.

#### **8th District Council Report**

• Jonathan reported: Lola's was approved for sidewalk dining on Cartagena; AM/PM needs corrections to their plans and then they can begin their renovations; March 6 the Land Use Element is coming to city council for a vote. CD8 and Mayor Garcia are holding neighborhood focus groups to discuss the issue. Norm asked Jonathan for an update on medical marijuana. Long Beach has a moratorium on "adult use" of medical marijuana for now. The council will revisit this issue again later in the year.

#### **Committee Reports:**

- a. Treasurer Report: Susan could not attend the meeting. Servando instructed the board to review the financial information and that any questions or issues would be discussed at the March meeting.
- b. Security and Code Enforcement Report Blair reported from LBPD's notes that there have been multiple robberies for Rite Aid, CVS, and Walgreens potentially by the same suspects. One suspect had in fact been caught who was responsible for some of the petty theft to these locations. Pellet gun damage to storefronts all along Atlantic Avenue. A gang member was arrested at Trader Joe's. This was most likely a botched robbery attempt; CSI has received calls from the beauty supply and smoke shops in the Gaska property about homeless and hanging around their locations. CSI suggests recapping the outlet at Dana Branch Library to prevent loitering and people charging phones there.
- c. Promotion Report Cheryl reported: Kudos for the annual meeting. Great turnout and content; member outreach on hold until Katie gets up to speed and the committee will meet again; Good Spirits is at Phil Trani's; Supper Club will be at The Mirage. April it will be at The Pan; Kidical Mass was a success and March is our Lucky Leprechaun Ride.
- d. Executive Director's Report Blair reported on an updated status around the district including: 4262 status, façade improvement at 3440, West Bistro, Ambitious Ales, Liberation Brewing, and introduction of new staff.
- e. Project Manager's Report No report this month.
