- Tree and Menorah Lighting Ceremony We have a bit of a logistics problem for our annual tree and menorah lighting ceremony at First Fridays. One would be to put the tree and menorah on the overhang of Expo near the entrance. People could gather in front and listen to the "all-star choir" playing in our old office location. The challenge here is that the Uptown Village Market is in the building and will have vendors set up in front. Christy has agreed to save us space in front as well as 70' along the curb to accommodate the crowd. The trolley could come and park at the driveway and take people around after the lights go on. Tight area but doable IF we can safely have the tree and menorah secured up on top. Second option would be to reach out to Senator Lara's office and the landlord of 3939 Atlantic and put the tree and menorah along the front walkway.
